Are you ready for summer? Now is the time to add a heat pump or upgrade your air conditioner or heat pump.

Dawson Public Power District is sponsoring a rebate to improve the efficiency of your home's cooling system, reducing our summer electric load. The first part of the rebate is paid for the installation of a qualifying heat pump. Additional rebate dollars are available for customers who also upgrade their home's ductwork. The program is for existing homes, not new construction.

Details are listed on the back of this card.

Bring on summer!

To be eligible for the incentive:

Part 1...

- Install an Energy Star® qualified air source heat pump (14 SEER/8.2 HSPF)
- The heat pump must have an ICM (variable speed fan)
- A programmable thermostat must be installed
- A heat pump performance verification must be completed (NPPD will pay the dealer \$150 to complete the verification)

Part 2...

- Ducts must be insulated in unheated spaces
- Ducts must be sealed with foil tape or mastic

Equipment must be installed and work completed between April 1, 2008 and June 30, 2008. To qualify, equipment must be installed in an existing home, not new construction. Part 2 of the rebate will not be paid unless Part 1 is completed.
