POLE AND SECONDARY SPAN RENTAL: Applies to NPPD acquired towns of Brady, Elwood, Eustis, Miller and Overton.

TERMS OF PAYMENT: The above rates are net, the gross rates being five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within the discount period shown on the bill, the gross rate shall apply.

If service is provided on annual payment basis the payment for service under this rate schedule shall be due and payable in advance each year, and if not paid within the discount period shown on the bill, the gross rate, which is five percent (5%) higher, shall apply.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: The above rates apply to bracketed fixtures on existing District meter poles, and where additional poles or materials are not required for mounting. Additional poles and materials, including labor if required, shall be furnished by the Customer.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

1. Lighting equipment including lamps, fixtures, photo-electric controls, will be furnished by the District.
2. Lamp replacements will be made by the District at District's expense.

**AREA LIGHTING SERVICE**

**FIXTURE PURCHASE OF CONTRACT CANCELLATION:** The following schedule is to be used to determine the purchase price or contract cancellation cost of 100 watt high pressure sodium, 175 watt and 400 watt mercury vapor area lights to District Customers. All Customer-owned lights must be metered and cannot be located on any primary line pole. The Customer will be billed for additional material and associated labor required for conversion of light from unmetered to metered for lights located on meter pole or Customer's pole.

**LEASE PAYMENT ADJUSTMENT:** The basic rates exclude the cost of lease payments applicable to Consumers served from distribution facilities leased by the District from a community. Consumers who are in a community served from distribution facilities leased by the District and upon whose revenues the District is obligated to make a lease payment, will have the basic rates adjusted (excluding PCA) to include the lease payment by the following formula: Basic Rates x .10 for Amherst and Pleasanton, the Basic Rates x .12 for Brady, Eustis, Miller and Overton, and x .14 for Elwood.

**GROSS REVENUE TAX ADJUSTMENT:** Customers located inside the corporate limits of a community, upon whose revenues the District is obligated to pay a five percent (5%) Gross Revenue Tax, will have the basic rates (excluding PCA but including applicable lease payment credit adjustment) adjusted to include the five percent (5%) Gross Revenue Tax by the following formula: Basic Rates x .05 for Brady, Elwood, Eustis, Miller and Overton.

**TAX CLAUSE:** In the event of the imposition of any new or increased tax or any payment in lieu thereof, in excess of that provided for under Article VIII, Section 11 of the Nebraska Constitution, by any lawful authority on the production, transmission, or sale of electricity, the rate provided herein may be increased to reflect the amount of such tax or in lieu of tax increase.

**FRANCHISE FEE ADJUSTMENT:** Consumers who reside in an area where the District is required to pay a franchise fee, will have basic rates adjusted (excluding PCA) to include a franchise fee payment by the following formula: Basic Rate .03 for Hershey.
